AUSTRALIA'S DEFENCE.

Island Colony is Spending Twice as Much as Canada.

Australia's defence estimates, for military purposes, of October, 1913, amounted to \$16,250,000, showing an increase of \$7,000,000 over those of the previous financial year, 1912-1913. The year 1912-13 was remarkable as being the first in which the, year's quota of men performed their personal service in the militia, under the clause. of The Commonwealth Defence. Act, relating to compulsory training. Up to December 31st, 1912, 194,328 persons and registered their names, of these 73,212 were exempted from various causes, 61,593 being temporarily exempted through residing five miles from a training locality, 103,752 were liable for training and 105,725 actually underwent training. This quota was trained as recruits in accordance with Lord Kitchener's recommendation, and it is claimed that the results are satisfactory.

The magnitude of Australia's new organization may be judged from the fact that the 18 field latteries of the old force will become 56 in the new, and in addition there will be six permanent, field "batteries. During the last three years some 1,500 horses have been purchased for field battery purposes at \$125

The Naval estimates of October, 1913, for fleet construction amounted to \$5,000,000, and \$7,000,000 for

other naval purposes. The Canadian estimates recently brought down provide for an expenditure of \$10,400,000 for military purposes, and as the population of Australia is only about one-half of that of this country, it will be seen Australia's expenditure for military purposes alone, is nearly. four times as great in proportion.
