DRUGS ARE SCARCE.
Shortage of Castor Oil—Prices Increased.
Hospital authorities in the United States are greatly worried over the threatened drug famine as the result of the European war. The imports from Germany, the main source of the American supply, have been entirely cut off and prices have increased about 500 per cent. The work of relieving suffering will be greatly handicapped, it is asserted, unless American chemists and manufacturers come to the rescue of the hospitals.

Citric acid is one of the most important drugs that is jumping in price. This acid, which is made of lemons and limes, is used for making citrate of magnesium, citrate of iron and quinine, and citrate of iron and calcium, the latter two of which are valuable tonics, and are used after attacks of fevers and rheumatism.

The shortage of castor oil already has been felt, and as a result castor oil is being replaced by petrolatum, which is made from a Russian mineral oil. There is a fair supply of this oil, but the heavy demand has resulted in a rapid increase in price.

THE ANTIQUITY OF MAN.

He Has Inhabited Europe Between 250,000 and 500,000 Years.

In his recent work "The Antiquity of Man in Europe," Prof. James Geikie of Edinburgh University declares his belief that man has inhabited Europe between 250,000 and 500,000 years. All scientific estimates are based on geological facts—such as the rate at which sediment is deposited, or the rate at which stalagmites grow—that are very hard to determine with any accuracy, but no one doubts that man is far older than men of science originally supposed him to be. "When we reflect," says Professor Geikie, "on the many geographical changes that man has witnessed—the enormous transients, the frequent and general lowering of the surface by denudation, when we consider that he has lived through a succession of stupendous climatic revolutions; that he has seen widely contrasting floras and faunas alternately occupying our continent—the tundras, steppes, and great forests succeeding each other again and again—we must feel convinced that the few thousand years that have elapsed since the downfall of Babylonian, Assyrian and Egyptian empires are as nothing compared with the long aeons that separate the earliest times of history from the apparition of Palaeolithic man in Europe.



Duchess of Luxembourg.

The Grand Duchesses of Luxembourg is the youngest in Europe. She succeeded to the throne in March, 1912, on the death of her father, William III, Grand Duke of Luxembourg, being then within two months of her eighteenth birthday.

Serious and grave beyond her years, the Grand Duchess sounds every much like the late Queen Victoria, who ascended the throne of England when she was eighteen, and who seemed to develop almost at once into a grave and thoughtful woman.

Like Queen Victoria, the Grand Duchess of Luxembourg takes her duties very seriously, and since she became ruler has made an extensive study of international politics and all that concerns the welfare of the Luxembourg State over which she reigns.
