INTERNATIONAL LESSON, NOVEMBER 1.
Lesson V. The Arrest and Trial of Jesus. Matt. 26. 47-68. Golden Text, Isa. 53:7.

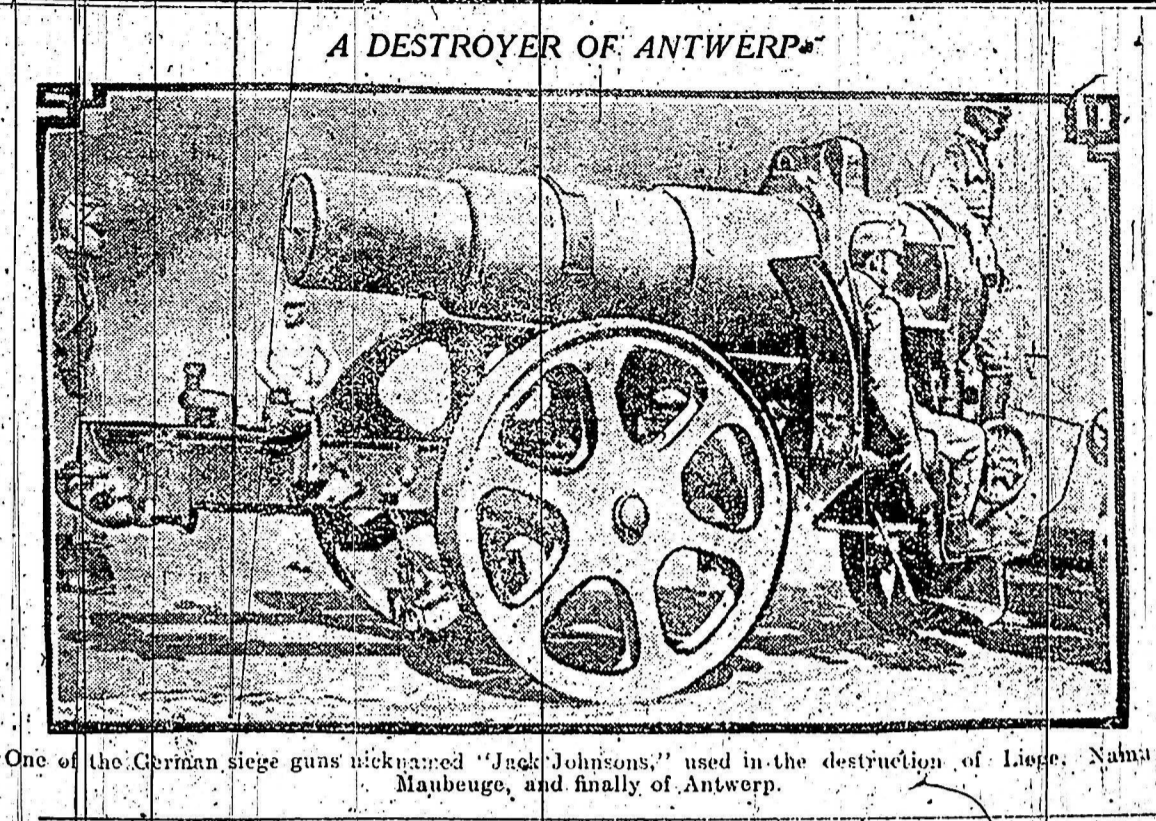
Verse 57. Where the scribes and the leaders were gathered together. The Sanhedrin did not meet at night. But the scribes and elders were not going to take any chances on losing Jesus. As soon as they sent their officers to apprehend Jesus, they themselves go to their assembly place to hurry through as quickly as possible his condemnation and execution. The world was asleep. They could not quietly with the fear of the populace interfering in Jesus's behalf.

Verse 58. Peter was more courageous than the other disciples. In his own mind he followed him afar off, near enough to see where he was taken, but far enough not to get into any personal danger. He doubted to see the end. This doubtless was an honest curiosity. He felt that all was up with Jesus as soon as the officers led him away by force. There was nothing Peter could do. He intended, however, to see what was done to Jesus.

Verse 59. Bought false witness. It was evident to the leaders of the Jews that there was none for his arrest to say nothing of his execution. One would expect to see the chief priests sitting quietly to hear the evidence which the accusers of Jesus would have to present against him; for they were a court of law sitting as judges. However, not only they, but the whole council, sought false witness against Jesus. Imagine these men sleeping down from their high places, and without dignity going about among the spectators trying to secure evidence against Jesus. As they bribed Judas to betray Jesus, they would not stop at paying for any kind of incriminating evidence.

Verse 60. They found it not, though many false witnesses came. None were able to falsify plausibly. Afterward, when the chief priests and elders and all the council were at their wits end to find some sort of evidence against Jesus, they had to be satisfied with trumping up testimony and what inducements were made then we do not know. But the temptation to imagine the worst is great.

Verse 61. This man said: The most of the two false witnesses could adduce was a supposed statement, which even the high priest and scribes saw immediately was not material or relevant. They also saw, doubtless, that the destruction of the temple and its rebuilding in three days had a spiritual as well as a factual interpretation, and that if he pressed this testimony against Jesus, and he should say he had reference to the spiritual temple, he would thereby make complete answer to the charge and clear himself.

GERMAN HOMES TO MOURN

The President of Prussian Diet Speaks of National Sacrifice
A despatch from Berlin says: Count von Schwerin-Lowitz, President of the Prussian Diet said: "The times are bad, but we should feel proud that we are permitted to live and see them. There will be scarcely one house in our country that does not mourn for somebody. Immovable father, sacrifices will still have to be made, but we shall show our enemies what unconquerable power the consciousness of fighting for a good and just cause can bestow upon a united people. We have honorably striven for peace, but have been forced away by jealous and envious enemies; not to fight, for a great sphere of power, the enlargement of our empire or our commercial profit, but for our homes and our families." Count von Schwerin-Lowitz said that Emperor William and the people of Germany were joining in their pitilessness to continue the war, regardless of faces, until a lasting peace was secured. He ended by calling on the Emperor and the army and navy to be enthusiastically.

Airship Bombs Kill Many in Warsaw

The Moscow correspondent of the Daily Telegraph has sent the following despatch: "During their unsuccessful march on Warsaw the Germans sent aeroplanes daily to throw bombs into that city for the purpose of terrifying the population. Very little material damage was done, but a number of people were killed or wounded." On October 19 so few bombs were thrown that a child was killed and a woman wounded.

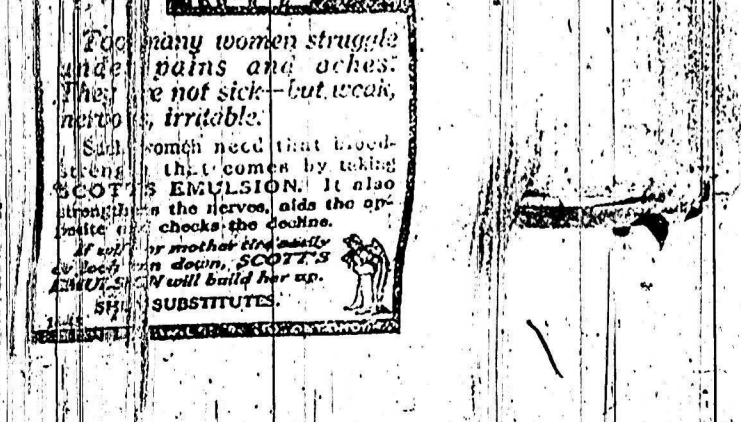
