With a little steaming these same cans could be rendered practically sterile.

One dealer who had recently installed a modern washing machine had some tests made by his bacteriologist on the results obtained. From the preliminary tests made less than 200,000. bacteria were found to the can and no undesirable types. Before the machine was installed, counts from the old one which had a much less efficient steam ing device, ran as high as 20,000,000 "He insists that he is not worthy of bacteria to the can and some were undesirable.
