Just how much the local inhabitants have been able to do for themselves, through the agency of 25 "Achieser societies" or institutions of brotherly help, is indicated by the six months' report of the main organization just issued. A Ccording to this report, the 25 branch societies in all the portions of Vilna took in during the past half-year just over \$15,000 and expended a little more than \$16,000 in helping a total of 50,000 persons.
