

TUNNEL ENGLISH CHANNEL.

To Be Considered by Imperial Defence Committee.

The long debated question of a tunnel under the Channel from England to France is receiving much attention in British Parliamentary circles, and the question will probably be submitted to the Committee of Imperial Defence. . The Westminster Gazette discusses the tunnel scheme as follows: "We believe that the tunnel can

be so protected as to make its construction a large net increase of our power to co-operate with an ally in Europe, and to provide us with a new route which will greatly facilitate and cheapen transport and supply of troops in time of war without deriving us of the security which the sea offers. Experience in this war has furnished a great many new reasons for providing us with such a means of ommunication, if these conditions are fulfilled. The tunnel, moreover, would be a door not only into France, but into Europe generally, and from Europe to us.
