BRITISH AND FRENCH RECAPTURE TOWNS IN BRILLIANT COUNTER-ATTACKS

Allied Troops Regain Moreuil, Monchel and Other Towns With Numerous Prisoners, While Inflicting Heavy Losses on the Enemy.

London, March 31.—The excellent news from the British front to-day cheered the streets in the bright, sunny weather and sustained the feeling of confidence in the result of the great battle which has prevailed all along.

The official despatches show that from the region of the Somme southward to where the battle line turns eastward, various fighting has continued on various sectors.

Paris, March 31.—French troops are now meeting the shock of German attacks on a 50-mile front. Failed at Arras in the attempt to take that place from the British and disorganizing the northern British line and finding themselves able to advance only step by step at great cost in their thrust along the Somme toward Amiens.
