The G.W.V. Day in Markdale.

The G.W.V. Day in Markdale was held on Thursday last, September 25th, and was a genuine success from every standpoint, notwithstanding the severe inclemency of the weather. To enter into a detailed account of everything that everything richly deserves a full report would occupy our entire space, and at the same time there were features which distinctly invite special attention.

The Parade.

The parade was headed by the Dundalk Band, immediately followed by a motor car containing Mr. F. T. Hill, Chairman of the Committee; Col. McLaren, Adjutant General of the 2nd Division (Rev. J. Thurston, Comm. and H. Mercer. It surpassed anything ever attempted in this place for originality, beauty, artistic taste and variety of character, comical and otherwise.

The whole proceedings opened with a review of the School Cadets by the Colonel at the station on the arrival of the noon train. The Colonel paid a high tribute to the boys of the Markdale Corps, and warmly complimented the principal of the High School upon their fine appearance.

The procession was marshalled on the beautiful school grounds, and at 1:15 moved enroute for King Edward Park by way of Victoria Ave., Queen St., Main, Toronto, Cavan, Argyle, Islay, Lorne, and then Main St. to the grounds. The casual onlooker could readily recognize the local tradesman in active operation as the procession moved along, but could not so easily recognize his neighbor because of his clever disguise in the Callithumpian section of the parade.

The decorated cars were passing grand, while Dr. McArthur's car with twins representing Cupid (that god of love so fatal to us all), and the Jackson auto with Miss Bessie Mercer as Red Cross Nurse representing "Peace", deserve special notice. We were vividly reminded of the awful war-out of which we have come victoriously by a splendid imitation of an airplane, constructed by Messrs. George Atton and Harold Beard. While Teece Boyd with his none too sure steady prong, as up to date with his referendum tray and none too well concealed bottles. It is said that the anti-prohibitionists had concealed a trap for our temperance keep, but he fooled them by saving himself at the expense of the cage.

The outstanding feature of the parade was the reverent and becoming half, made at the square where a tribute to our fallen heroes was paid in the singular led by the hundreds of children of "Ain't We Me?" Not a few were visibly affected by this solemn and bending memorial to those who will not return. In the centre of this throng, on the square, stood an artistically designed monument with a cross at the top, and at the base the formation of four graves the whole being beautifully decorated with cut flowers, reminding us of the heroes who had given their lives for the perpetuation of our freedom, and whose presence with us on this celebration was indicated by this memorial monument.

On arrival at the Park Col. McLaren took the salute and reviewed the G. W. V.'s and afterwards complimented them on their return to civic life and thanked them for their contribution to the immortal fame won by Canada in the Great War. The Veterans were under the com-

mand of Pte. P. J. Kelley.
