BRITAIN LOST 869,000 MEN IN WAR

French Deputy Compiles List of Losses of All Nations.

A despatch from Paris says:—In a supplementary report to the Budget Committee, Louis Marin, member of the Chamber of Deputies, has compiled from official sources the losses of human life caused by the war. The French army, by statistics compiled June 1, 1919, had lost at the date of the armistice, 1,354,000 men. Since the armistice 600 officers and 29,900 soldiers died in hospitals as the result of wounds and diseases. This represents 16.4 per cent. of the effective mobilized forces.

As regards sick and wounded, 4,103,981 wounded and 4,562,213 sick were treated in hospitals from start to finish. As many were wounded several times, Marin estimates the number of French officers and men wounded at 2,800,000. Of the 1,388,000 killed, 26,800 were officers. The number of French prisoners made during the war was 253,000.

The French naval forces lost 2,315 men, of whom 581 were killed and 4,994 missing.

Mr. Marin also has given the losses of the allied armies up to November 11, 1918, in killed, disabled, missing, and traced among prisoners: Belgium, 44,000; the United States, 114,000; Great Britain, 869,000; of whom 682,000 were from the United Kingdom; Greece, 72,000; Italy, 49,000; Roumania, about 400,000, including prisoners alive; Russia, 1,230,000 (the statistics from October 1917, are incomplete); Serbia, 297,000.

Prisoners alive on November 11, 1918, were: Belgium, 10,000; the United States, 1,100; the British Empire, 171,000; Greece, 7,000; Italy, 465,000; Russia, 2,000,000; Serbia, 82,400.

Germany's killed and missing total 2,041,000; Austria-Hungary, 1,500,517; Bulgaria, 101,221; Persia, 10,000 killed.
