

Glenelg Board of Health

The following is an abstract from the report of Dr. Hutton, Medical Officer of Health for Glenelg, for 1920.

In my report this year, I am making running epitome of the condition of several Schools in the Township, to each of which I have paid my annual visit. I find that the Trustees of some sections have made an honest endeavor to improve the School buildings and out-buildings. I have on my previous visits tried to impress on the Trustees the necessity of having the School House and premises made clean and habitable.
