"What astonished me most," he says, "was the effect of the storm on the trees. They were not loft standing with splintered and mangled trunks as they are in my home neighborhood after a great

they were bodily uprooted! ... "Examining them more closely, I discovered the cause. They had never been deep-rooted. The water was near the surface; the soil was fertile; there had been no necessity for their sending roots deep into the earth for strength and sustenance. They had led surface lives, so to speak, and as a consequence the first severe storm had laid them prostrate."

In order to withstand storm and wind a tree must have deep anchorage Neither beautiful foliage nor gracefu branches nor symmetrical trunk can insure stability and endurance. 




