## With The BOY Scouts

Boy Scouts worked night and day at Calgary during the firestorm, helping to keep the burning forest of debris carried down by the flooded river.

Boy Scouts and neighbors removed nearly all of the furniture from a burning house at St. Thomas. The fire had burned up the furniture because it was not taken and the house was finally destroyed.

Scoutmasters sometimes go hiking as well as the Scouts. Here's a story of a hike made early this season.

Scoutmasters are always talking about hikes and "overnight" camps. So last week four of them decided to practice what they have been preaching and one fine sunny afternoon they packed up their blankets, packed up some grub and started out.

"Sable Beach was the destination and they were looking for a site for a summer camp. The beach was thoroughly explored from the Sable River to the Saguenay Indian reservation along the shore.

"After this tramp supper was what everyone wanted. A useful little hand saw cut up some of the dry drift wood and a merry fire was going. It being hot without anything just the way Marie Dumas did it. A good number of fried potatoes, hot beans and fish and plenty of bread and tea made everyone feel better.

"Dishes washed (wood ashes are great for scouring) a good amount of blankets were hung for bed. Blankets were soon spread made into a Sable's sleeping bag and soon everyone was asleep. Then came a thunder storm which made some of us find a more sheltered spot.

"It was still raining in the morning, but a Scoutmaster who had had the circumstances of the night was soon blazing and porridge-cooked. The Scoutmasters were thoughtful enough to lay in a supply of dry wood the night before in a sheltered spot.

"After breakfast the party started to hike and hiked to the shore nearly to a good Bay and saw some steady camp sites.

"Owing to the late spring there was a great deal of water everywhere and the walking was bad. Scoutcraft four feet deep were found in some of the ponds and though the snow had disappeared out of the woods, the rivers and streams are no longer allowed to be polluted with sewage.

"Tuberculosis is now classed as a communicable disease and every medical man is compelled to notify the local and provincial officers of health in all cases of communicable disease.

"Contributions in the amount of \$100,000,000 have been made in the amount of health districts and each district is charged with a medical officer with authority to carry out the law. He has his appointment to no local body and his, therefore, beyond local influence.

"The sanitary campaign is being carried out in a very different way. Travelling exhibits show how to ventilate the sleeping room and the sick room, how to feed the baby and how to care for the consumptive.

"The campaign may reach a point where pamphlets and booklets issued by government auspices on all subjects pertaining to sanitation and health prevention rather than cure is the slogan. The physician is to-morrow the sanitarian.

"The baby is an object of so much concern. Infant mortality occurs at a rate that is an economic loss. Infant mortality is about twenty-eight percent of the death rate while the rate for consumption is not more than one per cent. Early toilet training of children and to Ontario every year.

In this trick you discover, by a few simple steps, the age of your friends. There is no little drawback to the problem—it will work only if your friend is older than you are.

Subtract your age from 99. Let your friend mentally add the remainder to his age. Then he subtracts away the first figure of the total and adds it mentally to the last figure and tells you the result. If you will add the number he gives you to your age you will have his age.

For example: Suppose you are 18. Subtract that from 99. That leaves 81. Ask your friend to add mentally 81 to his age. If his age is 22 that will give him 114. When he takes away the first figure (1) he is left with 14. Adding the 1 to the 14, he has 15. Adding your age, 18, gives 33—and there you are.
