Sied, presided and a part of the program consisted of a report of the recent U. F. O. Convention and an address by Miss Agnes McPhail, M. P. Later in the Science room Principal Carroll gave an interesting talk with demonstrations of accurate milk testing. On the screen types of dairy and beef cows were shown and information given how to keep a profitable animal. Refreshments were served and all enjoyed the evening together.
