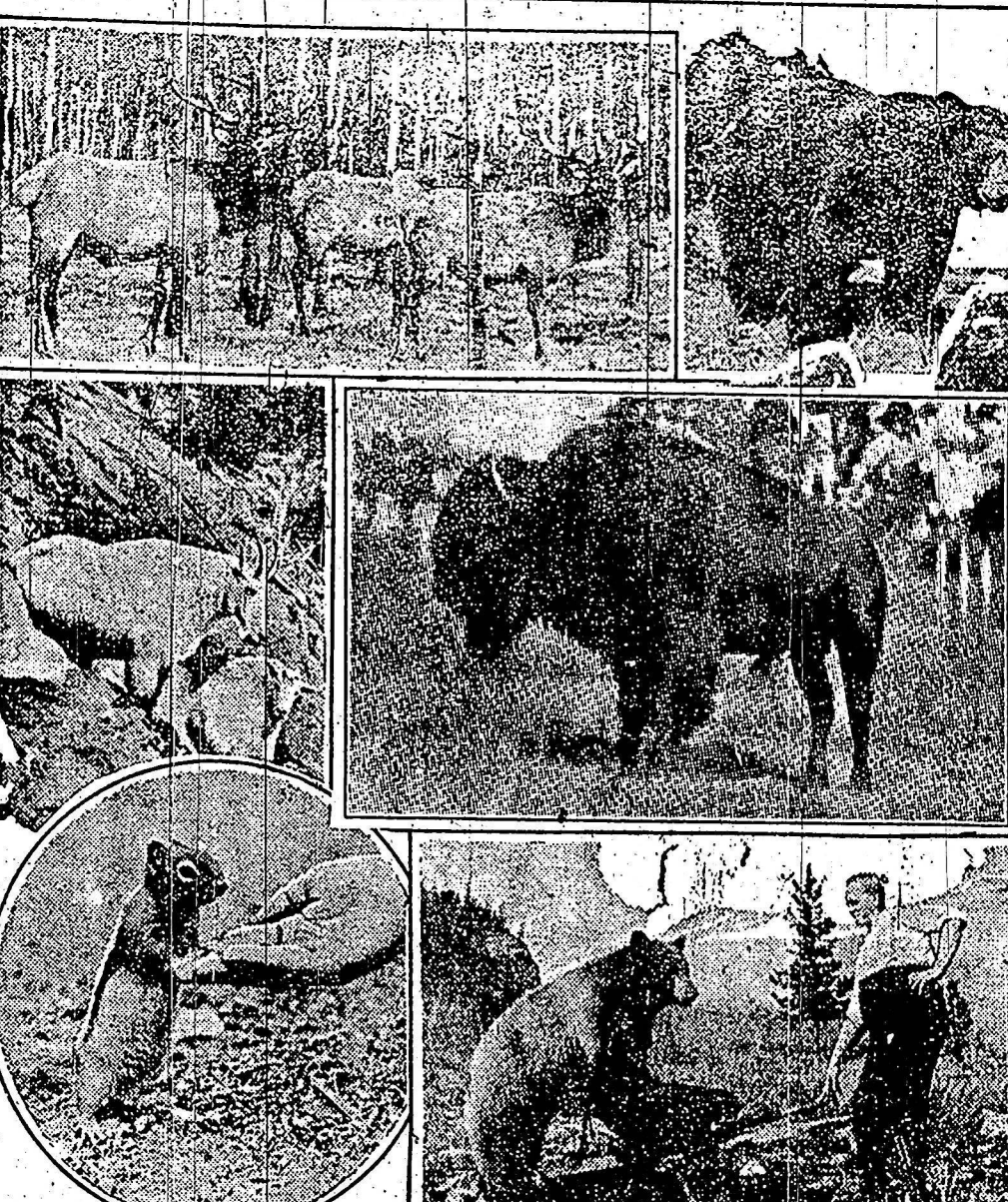

NATIONAL PARKS ARE GAME SANCTUARIES



The National Parks of Canada are a haven for wild life, where guns and hunting dogs are forbidden and where the animals have come to look upon man as their friend rather than as their destroyer. As a result, quite a number of animals are being saved and are increasing in the national parks of Canada and the graceful deer, the lionly bison and the always interesting bear live in peace in their natural habitat without molestation.

At Jasper National Park, in Alberta, which is 4,400 square miles in extent, and the largest of Canada's national parks, bears, deer, moose, mountain sheep and goats abound, and the visitor finds also great numbers of smaller animals such as beaver, squirrel and others which are becoming quite tame since they realize that they are protected.

At Watkinsburg, on the main line of the Canadian National Railway, east of Edmonton, there exists one of the finest demonstrations of the feasibility of game conservation, for there, in the

Poultry Mating for 1922

In regard to age of breeding, no cast iron rule will hold good. In many years of breeding, the general opinion is that second year birds are the best. But if pullets have been "forced" for eggs, and if eggs are not required before March, very good results are likely to be realized. It is when mated and bred earlier, in an unnatural season, that immaturity entails some degree of weakness.

When you have secured in especially good mating it is well to continue to use same male bird for two or three seasons, or until he is replaced by a good son of his. So with mating time right upon us, well to keep this in mind. The breeders of the heavy type Rocks, Wyandottes, H. I. Reds, etc., should watch for winter layers of early March. This is not too early, as it is necessary to let the larger broods six months to mature in before they are placed in the laying houses.

The number of hens to be mated is of importance. It is a general mistake to have too few hens to many hens with one male. A fair average for "utility" breeds is to give fifteen hens to each cock or hen. Every year the more the greater the development of the flocks, what his next mating will be, thoughtfully scans his best chick watching for their good points, deficiencies, and if the latter is apparent he discards such birds, breeding only from birds with good points—good size, general conformation to the standard of his particular breed, observing rule-always, "that no fault shall be present in both male and female, such a mating will make the most pronounced in the offspring."

Remember, even if you have had a wonderful lot of good hens, that can greatly improve your stock, a fine male bird, as it is a well known fact that the male bird is of great importance in the breeding business.—S. Knipe, Orchard Park, N.Y.

Gas Concrete.
