Deposits of Marl in Nearly Every Province.
Deposits of marl, according to Dr. F. T. Shutt, Dominion Chemist, who during 1923-24 was called upon to analyze some forty samples received from Ontario, Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Alberta, and British Columbia, are found in nearly all the provinces of Canada and are important and valuable sources of lime for land treatment. They occur in beds from a few inches to several feet thick on cold lake bottoms and are often overlaid by peat or muck. Some marls are almost pure carbonate of lime, while others contain more or less clay, sand, granite matter, etc., which decrease their value for agricultural purposes. Marls as found, are usually soft and easily in consistency, frequently show small shells. On analyzing by simple methods, they are found to contain a considerable amount of lime, and in some cases to be rich in phosphorus. The marl is a hard, compact, and heavy material, which may be used on both heavy clay soils and light sandy soils. It is especially valuable for the former, as a corrects acidity or makes an element for plant nutrition. It is also a valuable fertilizer, and in rendering the soil more fertile it is particularly valuable as an amendment for our soils.
