The majority of people never give breathing a thought until they are what is called "out" of breath. They regard it as a natural function that takes care of itself, and so it usually does. At the same time there is nothing in life that gives such general return for a little thought and labor as does that act of breathing by which we live. To begin with, it is the duty of each one of us to discipline our breathing. We let ourselves go on from year to year breathing with a tiny fraction of our apparatus till by and by come on the attack of pneumonia or of bronchitis, some disease of life and death matter that we should be able to control easily, and if it is too late we have never been master now.

You need only watch people as you see them in the shops, at the motion pictures, on the cars on the pavement, to recognize that the world is full of people who are half alive for want of proper breathing. You can see them walking with haltered mouths, stooping in their seats, lopsided, round-shouldered, with no color in cheeks or lips, unless it be from the rouge put upon underlined expression. Listen to them talk. "The winter is cold after another," or "If I could get through one winter without going, or I've seen to be a little before, I'll be all the time." If you dare to reply, "Ah, but you probably never do." In five minutes honest month's end to month's end" they will be offended, but not converted.

## Indigestion.

The term does not imply the complete failure of digestion, but rather the effect of faulty digestion. The symptoms of indigestion are not always clear, and uncomfortable sensations or even severe pain in the stomach may be present when digestion is normal. Indigestion results from one or more of four conditions. Either the stomach acts too rapidly and pushes the food on into the intestine before it is ready for the second part of digestion, or it moves too slowly, so that the food does not reach the intestine promptly for the completion of its digestive process. The secretion of gastric juice is at fault, too much causing acidity, and too little requiring a long time to digest the ordinary meal. Sometimes the stomach is of improper shape, and the unfortunate possessor of such an organ will be more or less of a despatch all his life, since the misshapen stomach is unable to pass the food along promptly, and its secretion is also usually defective.

Pain is one of the most common symptoms of indigestion, but it is also an unreliable one for it may be due to a variety of conditions. Some of them entirely independent of the stomach; thus, a displaced kidney, an ulcer of the intestine or even chronic appendicitis may cause intermittent or continuous stomach trouble. Nausea or vomiting is also a prominent symptom in many cases of beginning indigestion.

In all longstanding cases a very painstaking and thorough examination should be made to determine the underlying fault and to make sure that the trouble is really in the stomach and not in some other abdominal organ. Chronic dyspepsia are nearly all of low vitality, and they usually suffer from an insufficiency of lime in the system, in consequence of which they are likely to fall victims to infections as soon as it appears.
