I. Peter Has a Divine Vision of Christ in His Glory.—Mark 9:2-8.

For all the journey he made, he had the joy, too, of seeing his great discovery become incorporated in surgical science.

It has been said that those wounded in war, who obeyed the surgeon's orders, were given a chance of recovery and lives.

His life is not only immensely interesting, but holds a great inspiration.

His forefathers were quakers, and plain tradesmen and freemen of the City of London. From his father, whose work and investigations in optics gained a

heraldry of the Royal Society, he inherited a love of science, and whilst at school he wrote essays on "The Human Structure," and similar subjects.

He dissected fish and small animals, and articulated their skeletons.

Then, still a child, he suddenly announced that when he grew up he would be a surgeon.

When his husband died in 1885, Mrs. King was left to direct a vast estate that was then holding more than a large tract of land in a border wilderness. She faced the task courageously and transformed South Texas into an area of thriving prosperity. The estate is now valued at over \$75,000,000.
