

They range rom treatment of the affliction after t appears on the skin to eradication of the plant. On this latter point, hose sensitive to the plant feel strongy and point out that, since the vicims are merely people and not pigs or narcissus bulbs, it will be long before we can hope for legislation that makes harboring poison by a misdemeanor. 
