Assessors Must Follow Act

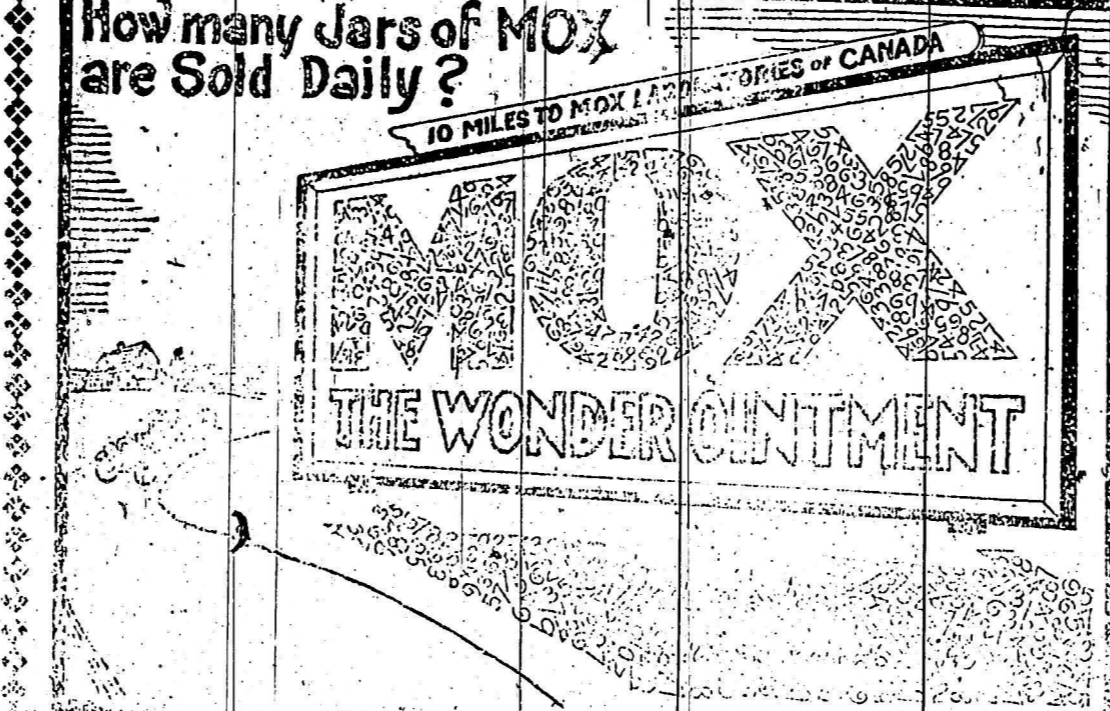
Every council is required to appoint an assessor or assessment commissioner who on appointment becomes a statutory officer.
