
he hub of Latin American dirways is rapidly being realized. ipidly being realized.

Awards of contracts for the carrying of mail between the United States, Cuba, Porto Rico and Panama are being received by the Pan-American Airways Incorporated, Tais concern, owned by United States capitalists, is purchasing new equipment costing millions of dollars, in luding six new planes.

Each machine is equipped with three 400-horsepower motors and has a load capacity of twelve passengers and 1,000 pounds of freight. The company has called for bids on larger planes capable of carrying twenty rassengers and more freight. Cuba, Porto Rico, Mexico, Honduras. Nicaragua and Panama are being studied by engineers and suitable sites are being selected for landing fields. Two fields already established at Key West and Havana are be-

ng reconditioned and air depots costing \$1,000,000 are being developed. Details' of the Panama service are .. now being worked out and, with continued present progress, will be ready next week. In the mean time the United States-Cuban mail and passenger services are in force and in the near future the Island of Cuba will be linked up with a domestic service comecting Havana, Santa Clara, Camaguey and Santiago de Cubs; while the line at Miami will serve Porto Rico.
