

Ailens in Canada

London Financial News: Migrants to Canada from this country have actually been fewer during the last two years than those from other countries excluding the United States For this the reasons are chiefly that Canadian farming in the post-war period has been depressed, and the Canadian immigration rules will not admit people who intend to get employment in industry. This rule bears with special severity upon the British emigrant, and is the chief reason for the comparative growth of the non-British immigrant into Canada.
