Investigator Finds 1927 Tragedies in Solomons, Had No Real Revolutionary Basis

REVENGE A MOTIVE

Nearly 70 years ago reports came from the Solomons Islands, in the Pacific, of a revolt among the natives in which members of the Solomons Constabulary had been slain at Guadalcanal and Malaita. It was reported that several weeks of the killings were the precursors of a general rising of the islanders. Later information revealed that certain members of the Solomons Constabulary of the island of Guadalcanal had indeed, at Verakona on February 14, 1927, slain three members of the armed constabulary named Funanusa, Gena and Yekka together with a boy named Kikipeta, who happened to be in their company. It was also reported that the three constabulary members had been arrested and tried for the crimes of whom they were acquitted, and were then hanged.

A few weeks previously W. L. Bell, District Officer at Malaita, had been killed in a fight which followed because the constabulary and the natives, led by a man named C. L. L. L., a cadet in the Malaita Constabulary, and a chief named Gena, as well as twelve members of the native constabulary, were concerned in this fight. 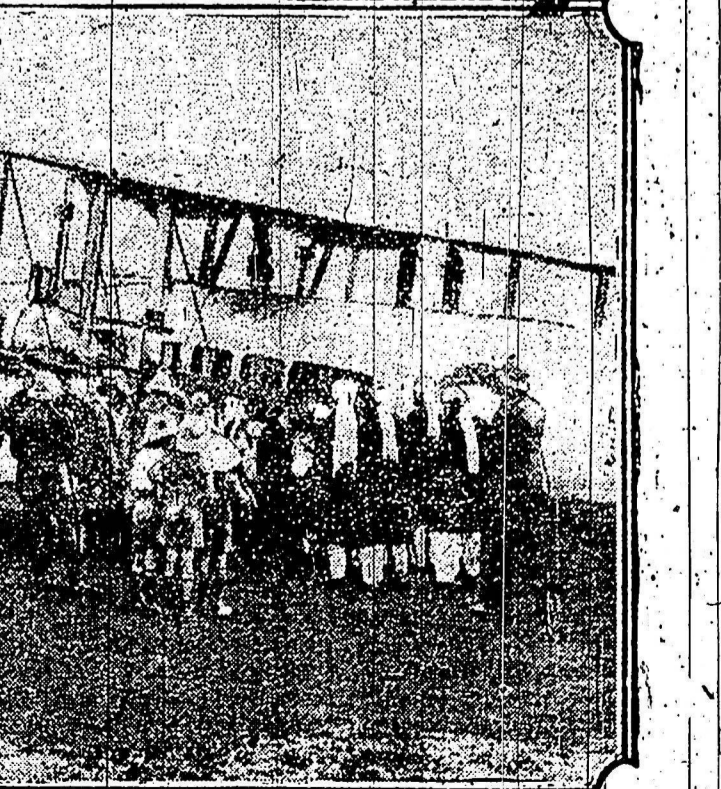
