### GLENELG COUNCIL

Council met February 9, all members present. R. W. is the chair. The minutes of last meeting were read and adopted as read. Communications from Dr. Campbell, re indications of flood over the T. S. Cooper, statement of Recs. and Expenditure of School Fund by-law 710, providing for expenditure on Roads and Bridges for 1929, was passed. Ontario Townships Roads Association, membership and convention. Minister of Highways, re Good Roads Association Annual Convention; R. C. Muir, Dept. of Highways, acknowledging receipt in detail from Road Superintendent Mr. T. Turnbull showing work and expenditure on roads in 1928.

By-law No. 711, appointing Parks, Inspectors and Weed

Inspectors of 1929, was passed. The Weed Inspectors are as follows:

Ward 1, Thos. V. Bell; Ward 2, Joe Stoddart; Ward 3, Frank Muigher; Ward 4, Hugh Vaughan Jr.

The Road Superintendent presented Voucher No. 2 for Road Improvement, amount of \$1,000.00, which was passed.

The following accounts were passed: Mil. Black, on collection of taxes, \$10.00; J. McKechnie, 12 days' inspecting roads, \$4.50; J. Boyd, telephoning, 40c.; M. Keeny, refund of dog tax, having shot dog, \$4.00; Municipal World, Assessor's supplies, Statute Amendments and supplies, \$33.34; Markdale Standard, account dated Jan. 26, 1928, for Auditor's Reports and advertising, in 1928, \$35.75; Clerk for registering 17 births, 1 marriage and 1 death in 1928, \$8.75.

The Auditor presented their report to the Council, showing total receipts of year ending December 31, 1928, to be \$161,822.26, total payments, \$44,641.28, leaving balance on hand of \$15,109.98.

McKechnie—Boyd—That the Auditors' Report be adopted and that the auditors, Messrs. Beaton and Robinson, be paid \$15.00 each for their services. 50 copies of report be printed, and that A. Jackson be paid \$1.25 for search of Treasurer's Securities and J. McGinn be paid \$1.00 for search of securities.

Boyd—McKechnie—That the Auditor accept the sum of \$6.31 balance due from Holland re township work, 1928.—Carried.

McKechnie—Wright—That we pay Artesia township sum of \$5.82, balance due re work on Township in 1928.—Carried.

Wright—McKechnie—That the salary of the Treasurer be \$225 per year and that By-law providing for his appointment be amended accordingly.—Carried.

Wright—Boyd—That this Council offer a reward of \$100.00 to the person, or persons, who kill the first wolf, and \$50.00 for the second wolf, when proof is furnished that said animals were killed within the Township of Glenelg.—Carried.

McKechnie—McGinn—That Mr. W. J. Haworth be donated \$50.00 for keep of Mrs. Scott, deceased.—Carried.

Council adjourned to March 2d.
