BOOK NEWS by Arthur Kent &

"Dodsworth" by Sinclair Lewis, published by McLeod, price \$2.50. Somebody must have told Mr. Lewin that his scathingly critical novels about American life, are unfair, that they give the United States a black eye abroad, and that they do not give complete picture of the American. branch of the human family.

For in Dodsworth, this most significant and influential novelist does something that he has never done be fore-he obviously tries to be "fair" -to construct characters that are admirable as well as pathetic. And he succeds, to some extent least. So that "Dodsworth" may de cidedly be classed amongst his good books. It is better than the bitter "Elmer Gantry" though less . vigor ous and decidedly better than Mar






