Law Travels Into North

Full Dignity of Court Proceeds
ure Will Follow Crime
Perpetrators in Far
Northern Place

MURDER AVENGED

Edmonton—For what is practically the first time in the history of Canada, the law of Britain is to be carried almost into the Arctic Circle. A judicial party, consisting of judge, prosecuting attorney and counsel for the defense, will leave Edmonton to travel for a month into Northern wilds with Akluvik as their final destination. There they will try two Eskimos for the most serious of all crimes, murder.

The trip will be made by rail, steamship and automobile and the court room will be the strangest Canadian justice ever known, for, lacking proper buildings at distant Akluvik, court will be held in the cabin of the steamer "Northern Distributor," where wild-eyed natives, almost aborigines, will sit as a jury in the case of two of their own race.

Counsel lawyers will argue before a similarly-garbed dispenser of justice and all the formal dignity of Canadian jurisprudence will be rigorously observed.

Judge Lucien Dubuc, stipendiary magistrate of the North-West Territories whose post gives him the powers of a judge of the Supreme Court, will preside at the hearing.

The counsel for the prosecution will be Claude Darling, while the interests of the defendants will be looked after by Joe Clarke.

If the two accused are found guilty and sentence of death is passed, the date of execution will be set, sufficiently far ahead to permit of communication with Ottawa, if any ground should be found for a petition of sentence or an appeal, from the verdict for the Eskimos will have the same opportunity accorded to any in Canada of an absolutely fair trial.

One of the prisoners to face the bar of justice is one, Okushuk, who, in the icy fastnesses of Bathurst Inlet in 1928 is alleged to have killed Oksusk, another native, by shooting him through the head as he entered his igloo.

The killing is alleged to have followed on the heels of continued ill-treatment by Oksusk of his wife, Avacoma, who, after enduring many blows and much ill-temper at the hands of her husband, told her troubles to one, Nellikook, a friend. Nellikook, it is alleged, held grudge against the husband, tried to kill him and who made himself unpopular in the tribe by his bullying and cruel disposition.

Nellikook and Avacoma sought council of one Eshaklak, a man of much influence in the tribe, and the three agreed that Oksusk must die.

Oshchuk was sought out and the story told to him.

He, too, decided that Oksusk must be got rid of and agreed to do so. He went to Oksusk's igloo to await his homecoming.

In the early autumn twilight, pre-

dicted to the long Arctic night, Oksusk was heard approaching, crawling on his hands and knees through the tunnel-like entrance to the igloo. As he emerged and started to rise to his feet a rifle spoke and a heavy bullet entered his skull above the left eye, tore through his vitals and emerged at the lower part of the trunk. He fell dead and the body was concealed under heavy stones. Avacoma was a widow and the killing was not spoken of in the councils of the tribe.

Months later, a mounted police officer, making his customary visit to the tribe, heard of the tragedy. The body was recovered, and Oshchuk was placed under arrest.
