And hardly a finger Of light shows through, To give them again Their old bright hue.

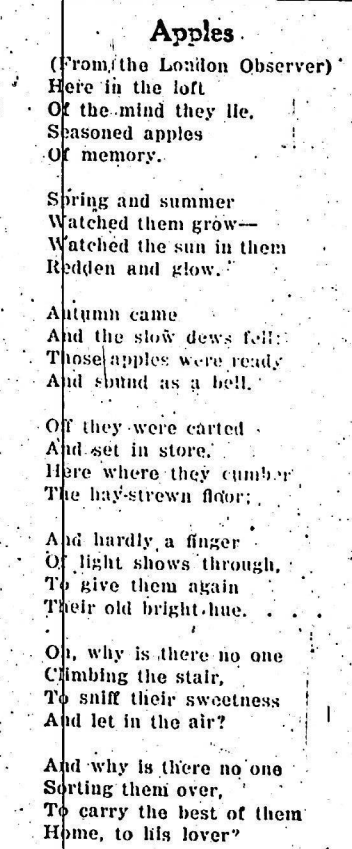
