## Minute Plants Cause Diseases Of Skin, Scientists Discover

### Fungus Infection on Hands or Feet Often Mistaken for Eczema, Doctor Warns Against Substances That Scrape Cuticle

Invasion of the minute layers of the skin of the hands and feet by microscopic living plants has recently been discovered by scientists as the cause of many skin diseases, a discovery which has led to a new method of treatment, according to Dr. Charles F. Pugh, chief dermatologist of the Georgetown Hospital, in Brooklyn, Dr. Pugh declared that three-quarters of all the cases of eczema, which is a common form of skin disease, are caused by a fungus.

He issued a warning to beware of all substances that tend to irritate or abrade the skin if "fungal infection" is suspected. There are many forms of these minute plants, but the most common is the fungus which attacks the skin and causes the familiar ring-like eruption and inflammation. Other types of fungi, if they get into the body, produce two diseases that in some cases result in death.

Condition Continues for Months Not all the fungi are dangerous, however, and some are said to be decidedly advantageous, such as the yeasts, but a large number, when they are colonized in the living skin tissues, irritate the tissues and produce a disease which is similar to eczema in its symptoms. Underneath the skin are patches of skin on the hands and feet, especially between the fingers and the toes. This condition sometimes continues for months or more. The surface of the skin itches and the skin flakes off. Underneath, the skin appears pink and shiny or even red, depending on the degree of infection. When it occurs on the feet the skin between the toes may be loose and red, soon drying up into a hard surface which cracks and bleeds.

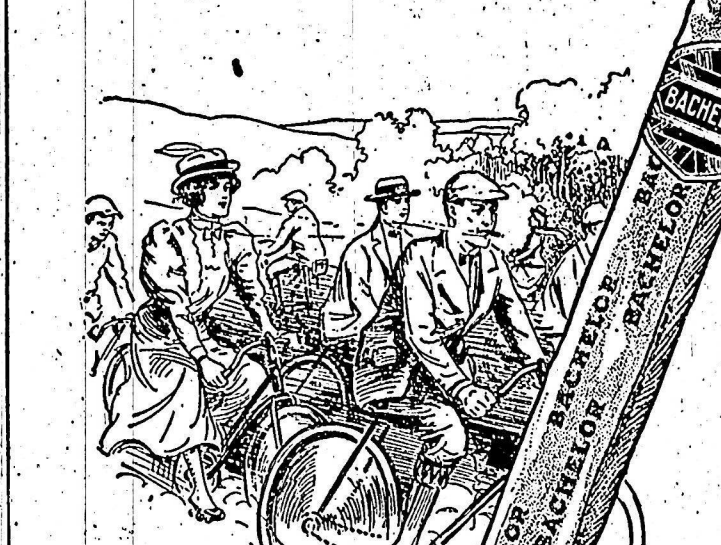

Canada Acquires New National Park

St. Thomas, Ont.—Canada has acquired a new national park, small in size, but very interesting. It consists of five acres of land in Southwestern Township, near this city, which will be taken over by the Historic Sites and Monuments Board of the Dominion, fenced and improved, and dedicated early in September as a national park. The site takes in the famous Indian battlefields, said to be the remains of a fort built about a thousand years ago by neutral Indian tribes who roamed Western Ontario long before the coming of the white man. These earthworks, said to be the only example of a double-mounded fort anywhere on the American continent, have attracted wide attention for years past.

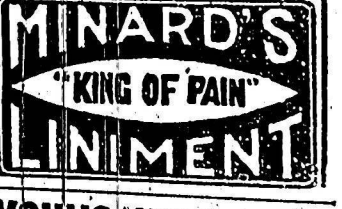
