

He says that for thirty years this annual fall phenomenon has been going on. Last fall he analyzed the water. He found a layer of water between top and bottom in which the oxygen was much reduced, and this layer acted like a trap to small fish. They could get heither above nor below it, until so nearly asphyxlated that they floated to the top. The extreme reduction of oxygen appears confined to a short period of
