Story Told of Quake Which Upset Fish in St. Lawrence River

O—Once every 17 minutes which means 30,000 times in the course of a year—old Mother Earth shudders and there is an earthquake somewhere in the world. Most of these seismic disturbances, however, are slight; many of them are never noted except on the delicate recording instruments of scientists; some cause widespread death and destruction and others may occur harmlessly far under the surface of the earth. For so long really stands on "solid ground" far below the surface the plates of nature that brought the planet into being again and again are still at work. Occasionally, an extraordinary volcanic eruption occurs beneath a densely populated community, as has been the case in Italy, and there is a major disaster with widespread death and destruction.

Two types of earthquakes, explains Father F. L. Odenbach of St. Lawrence University, have been the world's most noted seismologists. The first type is volcanic and the second is tectonic. Father Odenbach explains that volcanic eruptions are limited to the volcanic belt which extends in a shirako of the earth with a volcanic dipolements of huge volcanic islands.

The greatest volcanic outbreak in many years was the explosion of the volcanic island of Krakatau in the West Indies in 1883. Father Odenbach said, "So completely did the volcanic blow up the island that it was completely submerged into the sea. The island is now reported to be a reef."

Savages Feel Pain Same as White Folks
Although the Australian native of "black-fellow" is believed by anthropologists to represent the lowest and most primitive human race now existing on earth, the mental and physical attributes of these people reported recently by the Royal Society of Australia by J. K. Fry, show little if any difference between them and the whites. The children of the Australian race, Mr. Fry reports, seem to have slightly better vision than white children of the same age. Among the Australians, children or adults, the abilities of the eye are the same as among white people. Optical illusions, for example, are whites and Australians are equally susceptible to them. Australians have little or no appreciation of what artists call perspective. Mr. Fry found, also that they do not readily see "obtuseness" in a picture. This apparent deficiency turned out to be merely lack of education. In conventional life, when trained to see perspective as white children are trained automatically by seeing pictures from their earliest days, the Australians showed little as good as a perception of it. In fact, the perception and appreciation of numbers was also the same as in whites, although the Australians lacked such results of education as the multiplication table and other elements of conventional arithmetic. The same is true of the sense of touch. They were found to be the same as white children.
