

DENMARK'S TOMATO CROP Copenhagen.-One of the market gardeners from the island of Amager, which is known as the "kitchen garden of Copenhagen," has had a record year in the growing of toma-toes. He has sent 1,000,000 pounds to the market this season. In twenty years, Denmark's tomato production has increased from 44,000 tounds a year to 70,000 pounds a day, and this does not include those exported from Fyen to England. The growth has been so abundant that they have been sold at 35 ore—10 conts—a pound. One of the largest market gardeners has more than five acres of glass houses.




