Atoms Weighed In 2-Ton Scales

New Scientific Instrument Records Minute Particles

New York, N.Y.-Completion of a Swarthmore, Penn., is announced by the American Institution of Physics. An atom weighs about one sextillionth of an ounce. Yet this invisible bit of magnetic field, curve over to one side and fall straight down. They are


