Birth Decline Called Serious

Crop of Children Starting School in Ontario A Couple of Years From Now Will Be Sadly Depleted

A decline in the birth rate in old Ontario was regarded as a serious problem by J. Clark Keith, general manager of the Windsor-Welland Commission, who addressed a banquet of council of St. Catharines and Welland, and Lincoln and Welland counties in St. Catharines recently.

"These babies born in 1921 or 1932 because of school age in 1928, and it was immediately reflected in the school enrollment. If there is a drop of six hundred in school admission for the next six or seven years, it appears reasonable to suppose that you will have between 2,000 and 4,000 fewer students in our public schools at that time than we are now having. I believe that this will hold true in most of the older cities in Ontario."

He noted this would mean that a large number of school teachers would be deprived of their jobs unless classes were made smaller. It might mean that some schools would go into disrepair.
