What Science Is Doing

CHECK GAS GANGRENE A new treatment toward the control of gas gangrene has been discovered by two members of the medical faculty of Queen's University at Kingston, Ont., Dr. G. B. Reed and Dr. J. H. Orr. Their findings recently were published in Lancet, British medical journal.

The doctors developed a treatment which resulted in a startling decline in the mortality rate among guinea pigs virulently infected with gas gangrene, an infection said to rank with streptococcus as the greatest cause of death among

Sulphanilamide, sulphapyridine and sulphathlazole were used to control the infection, with the latter being found the most effective.


The quints have been taught only French "in accordance with the opinion of educational authorities that children should have a thorough groundwork in their mother tongue before being taught any other language," Dr.

Canada Plans Huge Surveys

Thousands of Miles of Mineral Areas To Be Examined and Mapped This Summer

Thousands of square miles of Canada's mineral areas will be examined and mapped this summer by survey parties sent out by the Department of Mines and Resources. The department plans to send 27 geological survey parties and nine topographical survey

The survey program emphasizes the importance of gold to Can-ada's war effort, with several projects designed to guide prospectors in their search for the metal and aid in development of active de posits. The largest project is ex-ploration of a 40,000 square mile area lying east of James Bay in

Quebec.
In addition, investigation of possible areas bearing other minerals vital to war needs will be made at the request of the metals controller G. C. Bateman.

In Alberta, parties will aid in the search for new oil fields. The areas to be covered will be in the four Western provinces, mineral areas in Ontario and Que bec and gas and oil areas in South-: 20:50

Vitamin D Is "Sunshine"

Allows Calcium and Phosphorous to Be Utilized

Vitamin D. the "sunshine vitamin" which is manufactured in the skin on direct exposure to the sun's ultra-violet rays, is something of a puzzler. Science does not yet know exactly how much you need, and you have no way of knowing exactly how much you get. But one thing is very clear; it is indispensable.

Vitamin D is so important dur ing growth that some foods, par-ticularly milk, have had this vitamin added to them. Milk is now enriched with D by several methods. One is by exposing a thin layer of milk to strong ultra-violet light which activates sterols in the milk just as sunshine activates the sterols in the skin. Milk is also fortified by the direct addition of D concentrates. Still another method is to add the vitamin to the feed given cows and chickens so that the milk, butter and eggs will STORE UP IN SUMMER

You can't always depend on get-ting your share of Vitamin D from these ultra-violet rays. In the ear--and in the winter, weaker still. In winter, they're only about one-twelfth as strong as in summer. So you have to store up enough in summer to last through the winter

The ultra-violet light cannot pass through ordinary glass. Fog, smoke and dust are further hindrances. Clothing makes a difference, too. Even the strong ultra-violet light of summer can get through only one layer of light clothing. If you depend upon a sun lamp, keep in mind that it deteriorates and should be checked regularly.

New Natural Gas Plant To Be Constructed at Brantford is Expected to Ease Shortago in a Wide Area of On tario This Winter

Construction of a \$300,000 plant for the Dominion Natural Gas Co. at Brantford, for the production of gas from propane, a by-product of crude petroleum, will start immediately. It will alleviate a gas heating shortage in a wide Ontario area, A. R. Crozier, provincial gas commis sioner has announced

Piping has already been ordered for the Brantford plant and a pro-duction of 3,000,000 cubic feet per day is anticipated.

The sys-tem serves St. Catharines, Port Colborne, Preston, Galt, Wood-stock, Ingersoll, St. Thomas, Till-sonburg, Dunnville and as far-west as Leamington and Kings-ville.

Q. How can I make a delicious


fruit sandwich?

Keep Records of Grade Dairy Cows
