

Spies in Britain Lead Lonely Life

From Arrest to Hanging They Never See Plain Clothes

Unless they are military men, spies of a foreign power caught in Britain never come under army jurisdiction and if convicted are hanged. If they are sentenced to death they are tried by a court-martial and shot.

What happens when civilian spies are arrested is told in the London Daily Mail: "From the moment they are trapped they are 'spirited away,' and never again do they see an ordinary citizen, except the twelve members of their jury."

First, they are taken to prison cells. Their police court hearing is held in camera, usually in a private room at Bow Street Police Court, London. They are taken from the prison to the court in a car accompanied by specially picked wardens. With them is a driver, the car is driven into the yard at Bow Street, and none but officials is even aware of their arrival. Wardens guard them day and night. They rest with their guards, and exercise in a yard into which no outsider can peer. Only they are visited by the doctor, and unknown to them a special observation is kept on them to see if they have any mental abnormalities.

In transit to court and prison, they neither see nor are seen. At the Old Bailey they are led into a special cell. Sometimes three months elapse while spies go through their preliminary proceedings in court hearings and the final verdict is given. But throughout all that time they see only walls and bars and officials.
