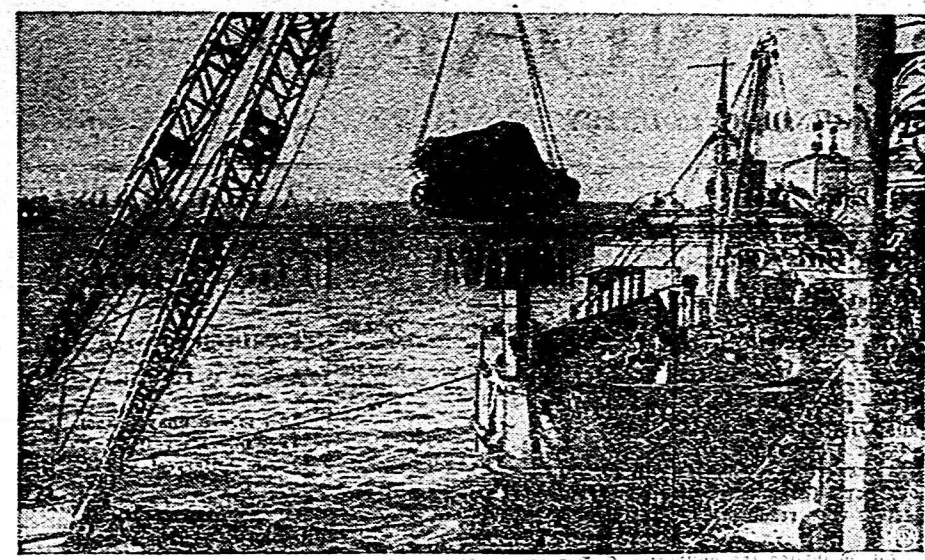


THE TANKS ARE COMING TO EGYPT

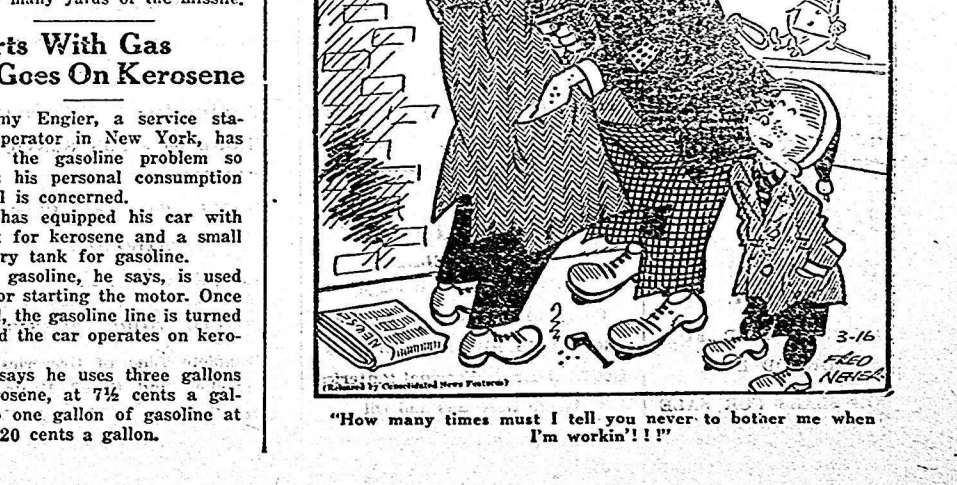

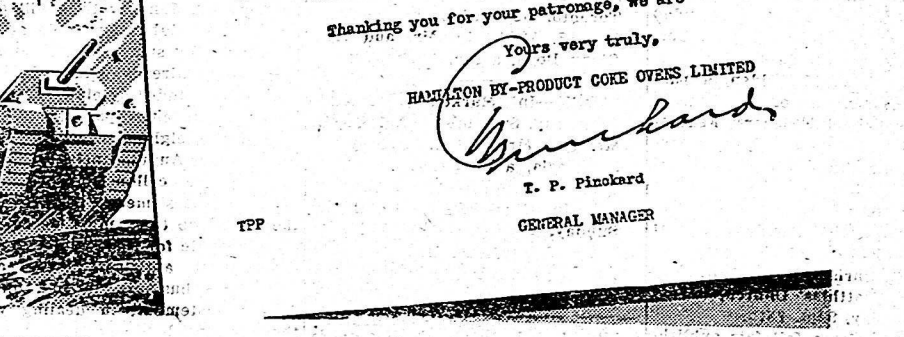
