McLaughry - Whitaker—That the Clerk advertise in the local paper for a Road Superintendent, for the remainder of this year, applications to be with the Clerk not later than 1st July, 1942, at the hour of 12 o'clock noon—Carried.

Whitaker - McLaughry—That this Council learn with regret of the death of Mr. W. J. Blackburn, a valued official of the Township, and desire to express our sincerest sympathies to his wife and family in their loss and a letter of condolence be prepared by the Clerk and transmitted to Mrs. Blackburn—Carried.

Communications were read from the following: Department of Highways re township road appropriation by-law for 1942; Dept. of Highways re gasoline; Dept. of Public Welfare re Provincial contribution to direct relief costs; Dept. of Municipal Affairs re subscriptions for annual report of municipal statistics, copy of municipal statistics from the Dept. of Municipal Affairs; letter Shop Supply Co. re printing Voters' List; Whillier and Co., municipal stationers; John Leckie Ltd., re flag; The Canada Import and Co. re cutters; T. Stewart Cooper, re meeting of County Agricultural War Committee.


Road Voucher No. 4, was presented by the Road Superintendent and passed for payment. The usual accounts were all order paid. There were three claims for sheep killed by dogs. The Council decided to send all ratepayers a notice asking that all dogs be kept from running at large at night. It was decided that diptheria toxoid should be made available to all children and that the township advise the Board of Health.

There being no further business the Council adjourned to meet May 2nd at 10 a.m. for general business.
