New Insurance Books for the fiscal year 1943-44 will be exchanged by the Local Employment and Selective Service Office in your area for expired Insurance Books.

Do not send in your Insurance Books without completing forms enclosed with circular letter 625.

If you have not received this circular letter, get in touch with your nearest Employment and Selective Service Office.

Where it is necessary to quote the Employee's Insurance Number, use the number with the prefix letter shown on the front cover of the book: example P-4947, E-22454.

Protect the benefit rights of your employees by following closely the procedure outlined in the circular letter, and prevent delays by acting now.

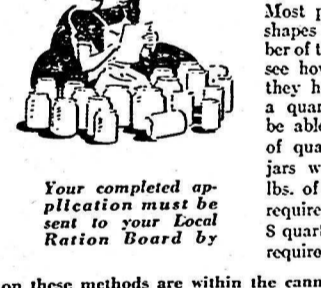

HOW TO FILL OUT YOUR APPLICATION FOR CANNING SUGAR

This year-housewives must estimate in advance the amount of sugar required for canning and jam-making, so that arrangements may be made to provide and distribute the necessary supplies.

HOW TO FIGURE OUT THE AMOUNT OF SUGAR NEEDED

CANNING Allow 1/2 lb. of sugar for each quart sealer.



JAM OR JELLY MAKING Allow 1 1/2 lbs. of sugar for each quart of jam or jelly.

Estimate the TOTAL number of quart sealers you plan to put up - then use the quick, practical method of allowing 1/2 lb. of sugar for each quart sealer.

Study this example APPLICATION FOR CANNING SUGAR

IMPORTANT NOTE The Dominion Department of Agriculture recommends canning fruit in preference to making jams or jellies because more fruit can be put up with less sugar and at less cost.
