Keep Eggs Cold And Also Covered

The way to keep eggs fresh longest is to have them not only cold but also covered, say reports from the Etah and Massachusetts State Experiment Stations.

The Utah station tested eggs that had been kept for a week according to various home practices. The eggs that rated highest kept in the hydrator of the refrigerator, as fresh vegetables are kept. Eggs rating second and third place were those kept in a covered carton and an open container in the refrigerator. Within the week those kept in a cardboard carton in the cupboard of a warm kitchen had dropped from A to C grade and some even had to be graded as "rots".

The Massachuseits Station found that fresh eggs could be kept a month without serious loss in quality, if they were covered and in a refrigerator where the temperature was held at 41 degrees F. Eggs stored in open containers like wire baskets gradu-ally lost weight by drying out. Eggs kept in cartons often absorbed the flavor of the carton.

FASCIST VENGEANCE: DEATH AND PRISON







Regarded as the revenge of Mussolini and Hitler for their action in voting against II Duce in last July's Italian political crisis, thus precipitating his downfall, 19 members of the Grand Fascist Council were sentenced to death for "treason" at a special Fascist court at Verona, Italy. Among them were Count Galeazzo Ciano, ex-foreign minister and son-in-law of Mussolini; Tullio Ciannetti, excommunications minister; and Marshal Emilio de Bono, who led — and badly bungled — the 1935 Ethiopian invasion. A firing squad executed Ciano, De Bono, and two other Grand Councilors. Giuseppe Pareschi, former agriculture minister, and Luciano Gottardi, ex-president of the Fascist Confederation of Industrial Workers. Ciannetti was sentenced to 30 years in prison, possibly for having turned informer. Thirteen of the 19 were thought to have escaped abroad or to be in hiding.
