TRANSPLANTING

Successful transplanting depend on two factors (1) the purchase of good, healthy, stout stock, and (2) exposing the roots as little as possible to the air. 

## Sugar From Sap Of Birch Trees

Canadian Research experiments birch trees produced an abundance of sap but the yield of sugar was on average only about one-third that of the sugar maple. Results of the experiments indicate that yel-low birch sap contains invert sugar with small amounts of sucrose, and that white birch sap contains a mixture of fructose and invert sugar. Syrups prepared from white and vellow birch saps by concentrating 100 times were similar in taste and appearance to commercial corn


