



Very deceitful creatures, those Nazis. Photos above show two examples of elaborate camouflage found by Yank troops somewhere in France after Germans fled. Top photo shows what's apparently the stark skeleton of a bombed building. It is a complete fake, having seen carefully constructed by Germans to fool Allied airmen into passing up the area. The "ruins" conceal large underground barracks. Also built to hide subterranean quarters was the "farmhouse" in bottom photo. It was pains-takingly constructed of plywood and netting, elaborately painted for realistic effect.
