

The Hercules will be able to carry a 60-ton tank with full complement of armor and men. Or, it can carry three light tanks and

equipment. It can become a mebile hospital, with 350 patients on stretchers, surgery facilities and plenty of doctors and nurses. And it could, engineers say, carry 750 soldiers equipped.




