1/2 cup brown steak and onions in fat. Stir in seasonings, parsley and flour; mix well. Add water slowly, stirring constantly. Add potatoes; cover and simmer about 30 minutes. Pour into greased casserole; cover with Bran Pastry. Prick with fork to show wedge-shaped pieces. Bake in hot oven (450° F.) about 20 minutes.
