



### UNUSUAL UNDERSEA PHOTOGRAPHS









Underwater photography, highly developed by the United States Navy for numerous war tasks, and kept very "hush-hush," produced the unusual pictures above. TOP: Sub-sea glider — a hitherto "secret weapon" — approaches the diverphotographer head on. Towed by a surface vessel at about three knots, the glider houses an observer who controls it by means of the fins. CENTER: Underwater camera pictures a Navy diver examining a torpedo net for possible flaws. BOTTOM: Navy Mine Disposal Service crewman at his perilous job of neutralizing a derelict mine. He placed small charge (box on end of mine) which, upon detonation, will cut electric wires leading to explosive inside the mine. In photo, he is anchoring the firing cable, Wire-cutting charge will be exploded from vessel after diverbas surfaced.
