Wallboard Made From Wood Waste

Wood waste in the shape of sawdust, shaving and chips is to be converted into wallboard by a simple, quick and cheap method recently discovered, says Marketing. Experiments show that a ton of sawdust will yield 2,000 square feet of board using equipment so low in cost that most sawmills and woodworking plants will be able to realize dividends from hitherto worthless materials. Present manufacture of hard wallboard involves reducing whole logs to fibres before processing, a method requiring a large capital outlay for equipment.

Britain Building Concrete Houses

To speed up housing construction and to save labor a new British structure is being demonstrated at an exhibition of concrete houses near London at Eastcote, Middlesex. Wooden frames and huge moulds for the walls, with the necessary openings for windows, doors, water and gas pipes, etc., are erected on the site by means of cranes. The concrete is then poured into the moulds, resulting in 12-inch thick, weather-proof and heat-retaining walls. The wooden frames and moulds are then removed by the cranes. The front of the house is built of bricks and the roof is pre-fabricated. It is estimated that the erection can be carried out, to a great extent, by unskilled labor and can be made habitable within a month.

Continued Food Shortage Likely

British Food Minister Sir Ben Smith believes that the world food shortage will continue one or two years or possibly even longer. He made his prediction in a speech at a victory banquet of the Worshipful Company of Butchers, an organization comprising leaders of the British meat industry. Smith attributed the shortages to heavy demands of the war and droughts.

The Other Side Of-D.D.T. Story

In the realm of research science, we have a warning as to the possibly serious effects of wholesale use of DDT, the new, poisonous insecticide created to kill tropical insect life and being used widely now in Ontario, says the London Free Press. From Chicago, Dr. Clarence Cottam, chief of the division of wild life of the Interior Department of Fish and wild Life Service, asserts: "DDT is effective against most types of insects. It is highly effective against flies and mosquitoes. But it will kill a lot of things we don't want killed. Our studies show that five pounds per acre in a forest will either kill birds or drive them out. More than one-half pound per acre is damaging to fish, turtles and frogs. DDT is effective against pollinating insects essential in fruit production. It is highly effective against bees."
