Garden Notes

Water Well And They Will Live
The secret of success in transplanting lies in keeping roots moist and so far as possible excluded from the air. No matter if the being transplanted is a tiny seedling or a ten foot ornamental tree that same rule applies. It is not the shock of moving so much as the roots drying out that kills.

To prevent this, nurserymen pack all roots carefully usually in damp moss, and then to make doubly sure they wrap tightly in burlap or oiled paper. When this nursery stock is bought it should be kept in a cool, moist place until planted and, if possible in the case of big stuff like hollyhubs and trees sprinkle some water over the packed roots to keep them moist.

After moving plants from one location to another in the garden it is advisable to dig carefully, keeping as much soil attached to the roots as possible, planting quickly in the permanent position, firming new soil tightly about the roots, and watering. Again the same holds no matter how small or big the plant is being moved.

TABLE TALKS

Most people love a good roast of veal, but does every one know how to cook it? Long, slow cooking in a slow oven will cook veal well and still keep it juicy. Experiments have shown that a maintained temperature of 325 deg. F. will do the trick, provided the required length of time is allowed, 50 to 35 minutes per pound is considered best.

For top of the stove cooking, moist heat and low-simmering temperature will tenderize the meat and keep the fine even texture. Boiling temperature tends to make veal stringy.

Veal Gouash
1 1/2 lbs. stewing veal
3 tablespoons flour
3/4 teaspoon salt
Dash of pepper
1 teaspoon fat
1/2 cup sliced onions
1/2 cup chili sauce
1 teaspoon paprika
1 1/2 c. boiling water OR tomato juice
