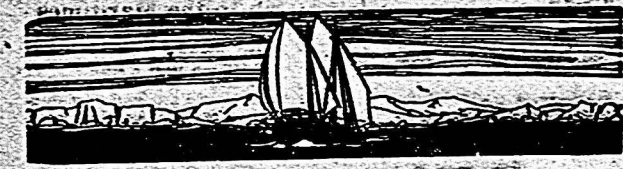

Preventable Diseases Take Tragic Toll

Whooping cough, diphtheria and scarlet fever—all preventable diseases—take a greater annual toll of lives than tuberculosis (consumption) does.

In a statement issued in connection with the National Immunization Week, Sept. 29-Oct. 5, the League said the polio outbreak is "tragic" but warned that other diseases are deadlier.

Thousands of lives had been saved by toxoid, almost 100 per cent effective against diphtheria.

However, despite the availability of these protective measures, the diseases concerned still menace the health of Canada's population.

How Can I?
