#### SAFETY FIRST

Very few drivers seem to know what o do when a car starts skidding on e, snow or wet pavement. The Onice, snow or wet pavement. The Ontario Highways Department wants to remind you of what every experienced driver does instinctively, in such situations. When your car skids do as follows: First, turn the front wheels in the direction in which the rear end is slipping; second, take your foot off the accelerator but leave the clutch engaged; third, pump the brake pedal down and up gently. Above all, don't lose your head and jam on the brakes.

#### Creep Feeding Spring Litters of Hogs

Creep feeding of pigs while on the sow is a definite help in producing heavy, thrifty pigs at weaning. With a large litter, and in rearing early litters which do not have the benefit of sunshine or out-door conditions, the use of a creep is particularly important. Actually, all normal-sized litters will benefit from treep feeding and so it is good business to make it a regular routine in hog raising, says E. B. Fraser, Division of Animal Husbandry, Central Experimental Parm, Ottawa.

Creep feeding is merely arranging a supply of feed for the little pigs separate from the sow. Separate feeding can generally to done by boarding off one corner of the pen, allowing the pigs in the alleyway, or giving them an adjoining pen in which to feed.

from sow's trough. Then creep feeding should be started, and should be continued until weaning at six to eight weeks of age. The pigs can even be continued on the same feed for a time after weaning.

The feed mixture for creep feeding can be made up at home, or a commercial pig starter may be used. In home mixing, it is important that the feed be palatable and low in fibre. Equal parts of sifted oat chop and middlings or cracked wheat makes a good mixture for the young pigs. To this should be added some high protein feed. Fish meal, tankage, or a protein-mineral supplement can be added to the feed mixture at the rate of 10 to 15 per cent. Minerals are desirable except where a protein-mineral supplement is used, and two to three per cent. of a simple mineral mixture should be added to the grain. The dry feed mixture should be feed sparingly but often, and fresh water kept always available in a separate trough.

Where sweet skim-milk is available it will smolt the light protein feed to


