Protestants in U.S. Plan New Churches

Protestant churches in the United States are planning new buildings costing \$50,000,000 as soon as materials are available. At a meeting of the North American Conference of Protestant Churches in New York recently, reports News-week, 150 architects and church men discussed new trends in Protestant church building and what was good or bad about them.
The most specific trend is toward a "sanctuary" with altar and chancel (choir divided in facing sections) rather than an auditorium-type room with the choir facing the congregation. Church plans call for recreational halls, bowling alleys, kitchens and parlors with cheerful fireplaces. Of 100 plans for new churches displayed, less than six were of modernistic design. Clergymen want their churches to look like churches, and joined architects in deprecating styles they termed "Cherokee Gothic" and "Classical Portland Cement."

The Good Shepherd
John 10: 1-16

Golden Text.—I am the good shepherd: the good shepherd giveth his life for the sheep.—John 10: 11.

The sheepfold
The shepherd pictures the salvation, safety and sustenance of the sheep. The parable is radiant with metaphor.

The sheep represent God's people; the shepherd, God's kingdom; the door, the entrance into the kingdom; the porter, the Father, or as some think, the Holy Spirit; the thief and robbers, the enemies of the flock; the stranger, the false religious teacher; the shepherd, chiefly the Divine Shepherd, but secondarily the human shepherd under divine appointment.

The Shepherd's Work
The shepherd's work in the present is the protection and progress of his flock. Contrast with him the hireling who may be in mercenary charge of the flock. He is not a shepherd in any sense of the term. He is not the owner of one single sheep.

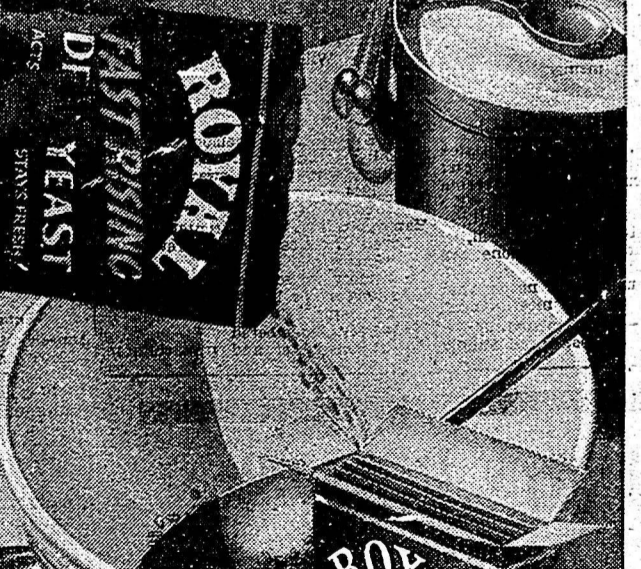
Dark Egg Yolks

Feeding experiments with Battered Rock Pullets at the Dominion Experimental Station, Harrow, Ont., have shown that due to the nature of the diet, quantities of succulent green feed, such as cut and steamed alfalfa hay, have a tendency to intensify the colour of egg yolks. Eggs with rich coloured yolks are more favoured in the overseas market because a darker yolk is generally accepted as an indication of a satisfactory diet and the presence of valuable food factors, notably Vitamin A.
