Historian Claims Hitler Really Dead

The legend that Hitler was not dead was so persistent that to avert its political dangers in Germany the British government in September 1945 commissioned a noted historian, Mr. H. F. Trevor-Roper, to examine into all the evidence of the last hours of the infamous dictator in the underground "bunker" where with Eva Braun he took refuge as the Red Army was breaking into his flame-and-bomb sheltered capital, says the Ottawa Citizen.
