Holland Council Council met on April 1st, 1947, for the transaction of general business. All members of the Council were present with the exception of W. M. Morrow, who was confined to the house through illness. Stuart Howey, Reeve, presided. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and confirmed.

Jackson - Sowerby—That the gravel contract be let to the Sandy Contracting Co. of Goderich at a flat rate of 67 cents per yard delivered up to a distance of 5 miles, 7 cents per yard mile over the 5 mile limit.—Carried.

McFadden - Jackson—That the resolution of Holford Farm Forum re snow-plowing be received and filed.—Carried.

McFadden - Jackson—That the complaint of Elmer Foy that he was charged in error for dog in 1946 be referred to the Assessor, and rebate be made on his authorization only.—Carried.

Sowerby - McFadden—That Road Superintendent Voucher and Fay Roll No. 4, amounting to \$254.20, be passed and the Treasurer be authorized to issue cheques for the same.—Carried.

McFadden - Jackson—That all snow removal from this date be the responsibility of the Township and that the Road Superintendent be directed to use his discretion as soon as there are definite signs of a break up, and that each snow club be given a statement as soon as possible of the winter's operations, and rebates made where indicated, also that clubs that are in arrears be rendered accounts and that the Clerk notify all snow clubs of this action.

Council then adjourned until Tuesday, May 6th, at 1:00 o'clock p.m.

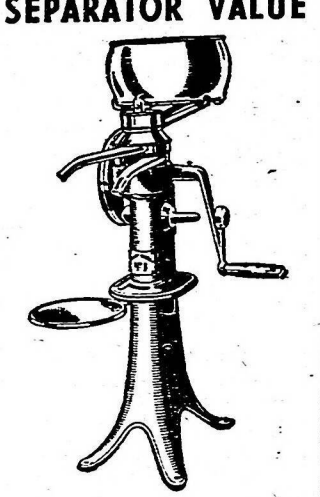
